To sign up for a Kroger Community Rewards Account, enter your zip code, click on your favorite store, enter your email address and create a password.

New participants will receive an email confirming their registration with a link in the body of the email. Next, click on My Account and use your email address and password to proceed to the next step. Click on Edit Kroger Community Rewards information and input your Kroger Plus card number. Enter non-profit organization (NPO) number for the Make-A-Wish Foundation®: 83867 or select the Foundation from list and click on confirm.

Then, simply do all of your shopping at Kroger, use your Kroger Plus Card, and the Make-A-Wish Foundation receives a reward check each quarter, based on the percentage of spending of our group in comparison to that of the other registered organizations. Kroger will award up to \$1,250,000 per quarter.

**KROGER COMMUNITY REWARDS PROGRAM: SIGN UP TODAY!** Please register your Kroger card online at [krogercommunityrewards.com](http://krogercommunityrewards.com) and follow the instructions to begin earning rewards. You have to enter our NPO number 83867, and to verify you have enrolled correctly you will see our name on the right side of your information page. You must swipe your registered Kroger Plus card or use the phone number related to your registered card when shopping for each purchase to count. Purchases of alcohol, tobacco, govt. assisted pharmacy expenses, postage stamps, Kroger gift cards, certificates, lottery, fuel, or fuel center purchases and sales tax are excluded. Eligible pharmacy purchases include out-of-pocket co-pays. If you do not have a Kroger Plus card, they are available at the customer service desk at any Kroger. All household linked Kroger cards will begin earning funds for the Foundation quarterly based on the percentage of spending in comparison to other registered organizations.
